China is the 3rd largest country in the world!



China is in Asia and its neighbors include Russia, India and Afghanistan – see if you can find China on a globe. There are so many people in China, that if all the people in the world were mixed together and then made to stand in a long line, every 5th person would be Chinese!





For over 50 years, China has been ruled by a Communist government, which wants to do away with all religious groups.

Many Christians have been killed or imprisoned, and millions of bibles have been destroyed. It is against the law to tell children about Jesus, to have bible studies or to tell people about Jesus outside of a few "government" churches. Yet many Chinese people are searching for the truth and finding Jesus, and they meet secretly in houses, forests and even caves.

In 1949 there were about 5 million Christians in China but now there are more than 90 million! It is said that 1,200 people in China come to accept Christ EVERY HOUR! This is amazing as it is very common for the police to discover and enter a home bible study, and arrest and put the Christians in prison for months or even years!

Chinese writing uses characters or pictures instead of letters. See if you can copy this - it says "God loves you".



Can you imagine sitting in your backyard singing "Jesus loves me" when some police arrive, handcuff your mother and father and send them to prison for years because they had told you about Jesus?

Chinese Christians suffer a great deal for their faith. In prison they have to work hard all day, maybe moving stones and rocks; they cannot be visited by their family and have very little food to eat. But they still continue to love Jesus and share their faith with others.

"Remember those in prison as if you were their fellow prisoners, and those who are mistreated as if you yourselves were suffering." Hebrews 13:3 (NIV)



Would YOU still love Jesus if YOU had to suffer?

LOVE EXPERIMENT - Try this so that you can see for yourself!

Decide to spend a day when you will NOT watch any TV or play with your friends. Eat what believers in Chinese prisons eat - watery noodle soup and a piece of bread for breakfast and supper, and cabbage soup and a piece of bread for lunch - NOTHING ELSE! (You could even use two thin pieces of wood for chopsticks!) When your stomach growls and you feel hungry, remember to pray for the thousands of Christians imprisoned in China because they love Jesus.

Let's pray and thank God for the freedom we have in our country so that we can read the Bible, learn about Jesus, go to church and tell others about our faith. Also let's pray that the Chinese Christians feel the presence and comfort of Jesus, and be encouraged in their faith.
